

The Time Has Finally Come

A fter years of preparation, it is hard to believe that our parish merger is upon us. At midnight on July 1, 2024 our four parishes will be merged into the Holy Face of Jesus Parish. It is hard to pinpoint when this process began. In some ways, you could say it started in 1989 when Immaculate Conception and St. Lawrence began sharing a pastor and the two parishes had to begin working together.

There have been numerous people who have prepared us for this day. I would like to thank all of you for your role in moving this merger forward. I wish I could name all the people who have had a personal role in this process, but that is beyond my limited experience and the limit of my memory. First, I want to acknowledge the priests and deacons who have served our four parishes over the last 35 years. Their generous service and foresight has guided our wonderful people in unity.

Also, our paid staff has done a marvelous job in uniting our parishes. You have had to discern what things we keep separate and what things we combine and how to combine them. Over the years, many of our staff members have moved on or retired. Thank you to all of our staff, past and present, for the ways you have served all four parishes. Many of your roles changed over time and you have adapted to the changes with grace and humility.

The members of Pastoral Council have had a tremendous role in responding to the changes. We are blessed by the feedback they have offered or the insights they have provided. Their ability to relay concerns and to clarify goals have sharpened our

communication and problem solving over the last few years.

The members of our Finance Committees and Buildings and Grounds Committees have ensured that our parishes are financially viable and that the buildings are in good order. It cannot be overstated how blessed we are to not have thousands of dollars of deferred maintenance weighing us down. Your financial generosity and the wisdom of our committees have kept our buildings, grounds, and budgets in great shape.

So many of our volunteers have adjusted how they minister to reflect this unity. Two or three times a year, catechists gather to share best practices and ideas. Things like the First Communion retreat have been blessed by a greater unity. Even our RCIA programs have gathered people from all four parishes to form new Catholics.

As we near the St. Joseph Festival, I'm reminded how our parishioners serve each other's fundraising events.

In short, thank you for making this merger possible. It is amazing that we are at this point. Without your willingness to adapt, adjust, and to love God above all, this wouldn't be possible. Thank you for trusting in the Lord and His Church.

With this merger in our rear view mirror, it is exciting to plan the future. Where will the Lord take us and where is He leading us? I can't wait to find out alongside you.

I have a favor to ask. - Fr. Sean Wilson." "Are you available? I have a request for you to manage discreetly." "I am currently busy in a prayer session, no calls just reply to my email." If you engage with the scammer, they will likely ask for iTunes gift cards. This is not Fr. Sean. He will never ask for iTunes gift cards or send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.


