

## A RADIANT FATHER'S DAY

The Book of Exodus is one of the most exciting books of the Old Testament. One of the most important moments is the giving of the Ten Commandments upon Mount Sinai. First Moses is given the Ten Commandments (chapter 24) and afterwards, he is given instructions on construction of the Ark of the Covenant (chapters 25-31). As Moses comes back down the mountain, he has been long-delayed and the Israelites have constructed the Golden Calf (chapter 32). In a fit of rage, Moses threw down the tablets and shattered the Ten Commandments.

After peace is restored, Moses is invited back up the mountain to receive the Ten Commandments. It is during the second visit atop Mount Sinai that we learn about Moses' intimacy with God, "The Lord used to speak to Moses face to face, as a person speaks to a friend" (Exodus 33:11). Moses conversed with God as one converses with a friend. In an even greater way, we are invited to converse with Jesus Christ, whom we see face to face. This is part of our devotion to the Holy Face of Jesus. We meet Jesus face to face and become His friends.

Moses' journey to Sinai didn't end with his conversation with the Lord. The Book of Exodus continues, "As Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the covenant in his hands, he did not know that the skin of his face had become radiant while he spoke with the Lord" (Exodus 34:29). While speaking with the Lord, the face of Moses began to radiate the glory of God.

This is what should happen with us after our conversation with Jesus Christ. We don't become friends of Jesus Christ so that we can feel good about ourselves or simply to feel like we have a greater connection. The goal is to radiate the Face of Jesus everywhere that we go: whether in volunteer opportunities, at the grocery store, or at work. The Lord invites us to radiate His love and mercy in every aspect of our lives.

As we prepare for our parish merger on July I<sup>st</sup>, the month of June is dedicated to radiating the Face of Jesus. April was dedicated to "seeking His Face." May was dedicated to "encountering the Face of Jesus" and we used the Blessed Virgin Mary as an example of encountering Jesus' Face. Finally, we are turning outward, to the world and our community to radiate the Face of Jesus. This natural progression happens in our own souls. As we grow in love for Jesus and in friendship with Him, we are compelled to move outward to telling others about Jesus and serving Jesus in the least of our brothers.

Our final Holy Face Holy Hour is this Wednesday, June 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm at St. Lawrence Church.

God calls us to radiate the Face of Jesus at home. Maybe this is the most difficult place to radiate Christ's face. We can take our family for granted and become easily frustrated or lose patience with difficult family members. This is the work of each and every one of us, to radiate the Face of Jesus at home.

This weekend, in a special way, we turn to our fathers and look at their love, patience, and example. In a special and unrepeatable way, God invites fathers to radiate His Face in the family. Fathers are given this incredible opportunity to love their children with tenderness, love, and encouragement. It isn't an easy task, but one that speaks to the heart of every man.

Let us thank God for the gift of our fathers. I cannot begin to count the many ways that my own father radiated the Face of Jesus to me. We owe our dads an incredible debt of gratitude. So whether your father is alive or has passed on, let us thank God for their love and sacrifice.

**June 28, Civility:** Pray that God would give us the grace to remember the dignity of all and invite others to do the same.


**June 29, Catholic Healthcare:** Pray that governments will respect the consciences of all individuals and institutions that care for the sick and the vulnerable.


