

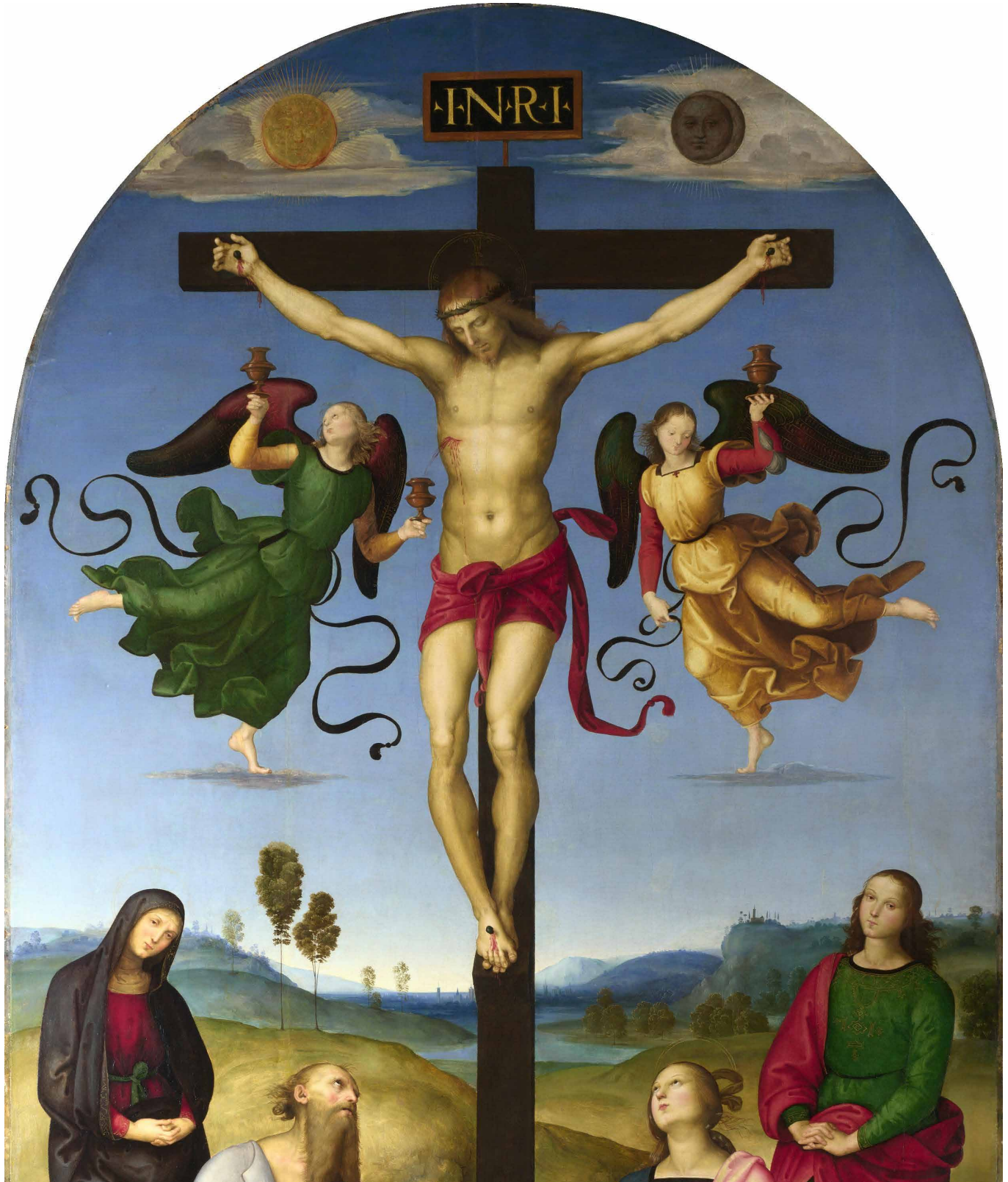

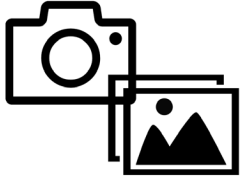

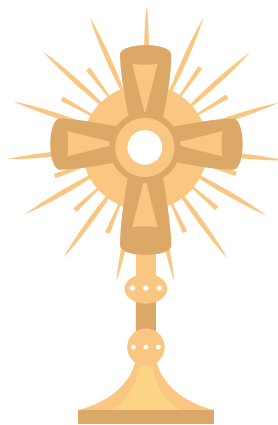
Tips for donating to local food pantries:

- If you have a large amount of produce, please call in advance to let the food bank know that you are coming.
- No rotten produce
- Offer only good quality, freshly-picked produce
- Handle fresh fruits and vegetables safely to minimize the risk of foodborne illness
- Don't mix produce types. Keep each type in separate, clean bags or containers
- Clean as much mud and dirt as possible off of the produce you plan to donate
- Choose produce without mold, spoilage, bruising, or insects

DIRECTOR OF LITURGICAL MUSIC FOR ST. LAWRENCE, RHINE, AND IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, BOTKINS

Holy Face of Jesus Parishes is hiring a Director of Music for two of its parishes, St. Lawrence, Rhine and Immaculate Conception, Botkins. The churches are located three miles apart in Shelby County. The position is 12-15 hours a week and includes planning liturgical music and accompanying one Saturday and two Sunday Masses. The Director of Liturgical Music also plays the organ/piano for all weddings (10-15 per year) and funerals (20-25 per year). The congregations are familiar with chanting the ordinary parts of the Mass along with the Communion Antiphons. Finally, Immaculate Conception is beginning the process to replace their current pipe organ.

Sean. He will never ask for iTunes gift cards or send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a message, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.**

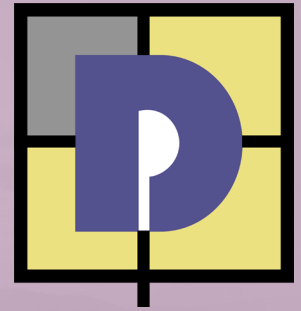

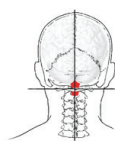
