A MASS SETTING

In Advent, we began using the St. Augustine Hymnal at Mass. Over the past few months it seems that everyone is getting acquainted with the new hymnal. It takes a little bit of time to figure out the readings, hymns, and ribbons. In Lent, we used the standard English Chant setting of the Mass, which is included in the hymnal.

Over the summer we are going to introduce another Mass setting. You may wonder, what is a "Mass setting"? In the Mass, there are parts of the Mass called the **Ordinary**. These parts of the Mass never change. A few examples are the Holy, Holy, Holy, Creed, the Our Father, the dialogues ("The Lord be with you" and "with your spirit"), and the Penitential Act. Other parts of the Mass that change each week are called the **Propers**. These parts of the Mass are "proper" to each Mass. For example, the biblical readings and the communion antiphon are some of the Propers.

Some of the Ordinary parts of the Mass are set to music and composers utilize similar themes and melodies. Maybe you never noticed this. Composers will set the Gloria, Holy Holy Holy, Memorial Acclamation, Great Amen, and Lamb of God to similar melodies. This is what we call a **Mass Setting**.

All of this explanation is to let you know that over the summer, we are going to learn a new Mass Setting, which is included in the St. Augustine Hymnal. We'll take it in small pieces, learning the Holy, Holy, Holy, next weekend and adding another part of the Mass each week. To help us learn the Mass setting, we will be introducing it before Mass each week and send out a recording the week

before with the Couch Chat.

We will be using the Mass of Wisdom. This is a popular setting in area parishes, so you may have heard it before. It should be easy to learn, but it may be a little difficult at first. When learning a new Mass setting, the axiom, "Repetition is the Mother of all Learning," holds true. Over time, we will master this music and it will become second nature for us to sing. It will take some work and some time to get there.

Remember this week that Fr. Scott Brossart, SOLT will be present for the event entitled "Healing Encounter with Christ in the Eucharist." There are more details on page 6 of the bulletin.

In other news, I would like to ask for some prayers for my family. Last Saturday, June I, my brother and his wife, who live in Connecticut, welcomed a baby boy into the family. Miles Robert Wilson was born two weeks early and was born with a heart condition. He was diagnosed with the heart condition a few months ago, so they gave birth at a hospital next to Boston's Children's Hospital.

As I write these words on Tuesday, June 4, Miles is undergoing open-heart surgery. I hope that by the time you read this, he is recovering well with his parents and two-year-old sister. Please keep him and his family in your prayers. It will take some time for him to recover from the operation. Thank you for your prayers.


